<b>8 Pink Pearl erasers</b> (this kind of eraser made by Papermate also erases crayon markings so please do not buy any other kind of erasers)		
<b>1 box of 8 LARGE size crayons</b> <i>(washable)</i>	<b>1 box of 16 or more regular-sized crayons</b> <i>(washable if preferred)</i>

<b>2 pencil sharpeners</b> <i>(for the colored pencils because sharpening them in our regular electric pencil sharpener in the classroom wrecks it)</i>

<b>3 highlighters</b> <i>(for marking Bible verses and their parts in Reader's Theater)</i>		
<b>12 small glue sticks or 8 large ones</b>		
<b>4 of 4 fluid ounces white glue</b>		
<b>1 pair of child size scissors</b> <i>(blunt)</i>		
<b>1 regular size notebook</b> <i>(for parent-teacher communication)</i>		
<b>1 plastic letter size envelope</b> <i>(to put the parent-teacher communication notebook in)</i>		
<b>1 art smock or adult-size t-shirt</b> <i>( for cooking, painting and other art activities)</i>
